vegas biz President's Column

This month, I wish to talk about Aging Gay Men and Isolation. Many LGBT older people experience high rates of social isolation. We're twice as likely to be single or to live alone and likely be childless. Many older gay men are estranged from their families of origin. Most gay older men do not have the close relatives to lean on for help as the heterosexual community does. We feel isolated by society, even the younger generations of LGBT people.

This isolation is party explained by our community's place in history. Many of us lost lovers, friends and family in the depths of the HIV/Aids epidemic, so we find ourselves short on these lifelines, just when we need them the most.

But, before we start taking meds or become shut-ins, let us remember that our generation is still one powerfully large cohort and our numbers dictate that we confront ageism in our community. The good news is that aging organizations are here. You can not meet people as a shut-in. Get up and go meet people. Go to an organization like Prime Timers or to a local LGBT Center. Do not shut out your friends. Do not take them for granted and be willing to invest time in the friendship. Look for people who like older people and enjoy being with them. They are out there to be found. Be active and get involved in something you enjoy.

I have found that Prime Timers has been my lifesaver since I retired. I appreciate the organization and want to see it grow. I know we can help many mature men who are lonely and need someone to lean on. Please continue to support our organization. It is very important that we show our community we are strong and we are responsible for where Gay Rights are now!
